Swachhta Pakhwara

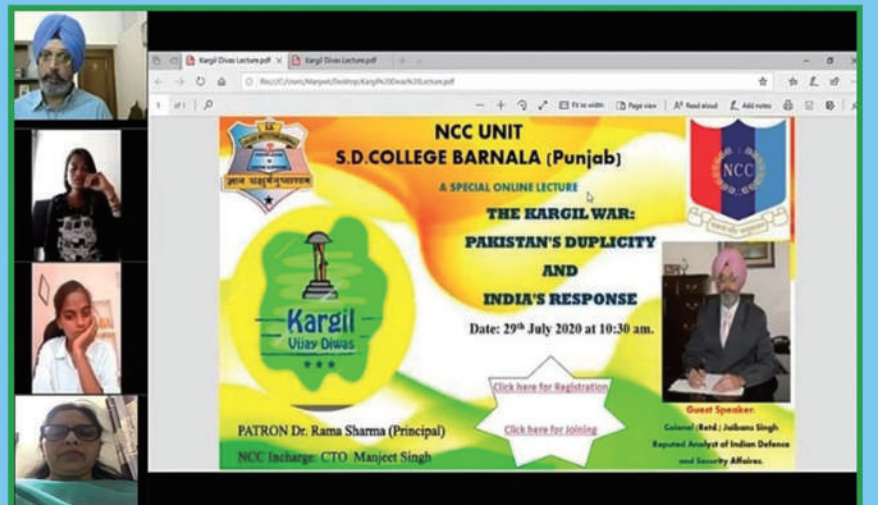

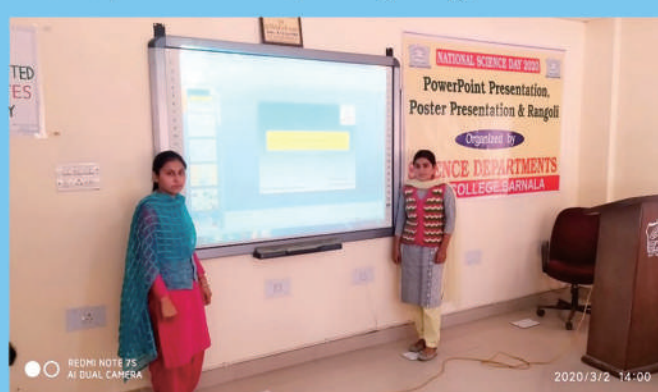

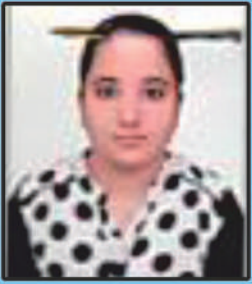
