



Career Guidance Cell

Cell Aim and Purpose

As per the UGC guidelines our institute has established Career Guidance Cell with the purpose to make students perform better. A Career Counselling Guidance is working towards organising interactive sessions from time to time on the issue of upcoming career options. The Cell intends to help the students to establish a linkage with the world of work and local career opportunities in the highly competitive professional domain. The main objective of the cell is to offer career counselling to students and guide the young minds by helping them to understand their strength. The Cell holds sessions for getting training for guiding the students for competitive examinations, basic communication skills, interview skills, aptitude test training etc. The students are also provided counselling to explore their potentialities and motivate them about their employment.

Career Guidance Cell of the institute is operative with Assist. Professor Mr. Satpal Singh as its coordinator and three more members. The cell has the objective to unfold the career opportunities of the students and instil confidence in them for the challenging professional world.

Activity Report Career Guidance Cell 2019 – 2020

In the beginning of the new session, the Career Guidance Cell of the College conducted a career counselling programme for the students of different streams about their career options as well as guide them for further studies during the month of July 2019. The main purpose of the programme was to create awareness among the students about various courses and career opportunities after 10+2, Graduation and Post-Graduation levels. In fact, it was a student-cantered support service programme to help them resolve their queries related to career options. The counselling sessions were conducted by the teaching faculty of different departments. The counsellors Assistant Professor Mr. Satpal Singh, Mrs. Amandeep Kaur and Mrs. Priyanka Baghla made sure that every student had their queries answered. 






Three Day Workshop on Yoga








International Yoga Day



First session of each day was theory session followed by practical session pertaining to implementation of that theory in making projects. In this workshop 49 students of B.Sc. NM (I, II and III) took part and enhanced their knowledge about the working of various electronics and electrical components like Resistor, Capacitor, LED, transformer, LDR, MOSFET, VDR, Relay, Speaker, buzzer, Preset, Diodes, transistor etc. by making electronics based working projects prepared under the guidance of resource person. On the first day, students of first year B.Sc. NM have designed the Electric bell circuit and also understand the concept behind rectification. Miss. 




Blood Donation Camp


One Day Workshop on Operating System Installation
