














## Report

This assessment tool allows teachers to collect on-the-spot formative assessment data without the need to have students use devices or paper and pencil. It's a data collection tool that's helpful for teachers and fun for the students. Plickers allows the teacher to check in on student understanding. Teachers can use this tool with previous planning or on the go as needed. This tool provides teachers with the data needed to inform their instruction. It provides students with the opportunity to participate and engage in learning without feeling self-conscious. Students stay engaged as they watch to see if their card was scanned, and their answer displayed.



## The Teacher as a Professional

Dr Rama Sharma presented a motivational talk on 'The Teacher as a Professional' on 12/07/19. She defined teaching as a process that brings a socially desirable behavioural change in a person. She described it as a process in which the learner, teacher, curriculum and other variables are organized in a systematic and psychological way to attain a minimum level of competency. Teacher brings specific changes in student according to the needs of the society and the environment in which he/she is living. She emphasised that professional attitude is a manner in which one conduct oneself in a professional setting. For that she advocated continuing professional development which is a planned, continuous and lifelong process whereby teacher tries to develop his personal and professional capabilities, to improve his knowledge, skills and practice, leading to the empowerment, the development of the institution and the students. The new generations have a different approach to learning than the previous generations. A professional teacher is one who learns new techniques in teaching students of this generation. Moreover, it helps the teacher to grow professionally, besides improving his classroom skills. She cautioned that teacher who has been in the profession for many years is usually reluctant to change his teaching style. Professional development programs will let him stay in touch with the latest developments in the education sector and help to change the way of teaching. However, willingness to learn new techniques of teaching and continuing professional development ensure that we as teachers achieve the right abilities to do our job and maintain or enhance our expertise. Thus teacher as professional embraces everything to improve his job performance. The presentation was followed by a thorough discussion by 43 teachers present on the occasion.

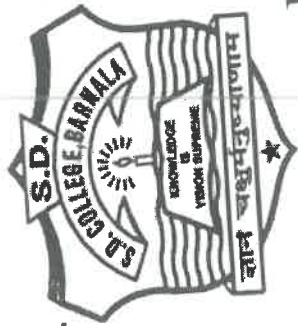
Dr. Harkanwal Singh delivered a lecture on topic "Academic Plagiarism: Causes and Consequences" on 14 September, 2019. He started his lecture by defining plagiarism as a act of intellectual theft. In simple words, copying and using someone's ideas and work as their own without referring to or crediting the source is Plagiarism. If you are taking credit for the work done by another author, then know that you are going to face ethical and legal consequences. Plagiarism exists in multiple forms. It does not just consist of copying but can also be an uncredited translation or the use of someone else's ideas without referencing the author. He also described types of plagiarism such as deliberate plagiarism, Self-Plagiarism, source-based plagiarism, accidental plagiarism, paraphrasing plagiarism etc. Further he also told audience about consequences of Plagiarism which could lead to ruining reputation, legal and monetary repercussions.

A lecture on topic "Academic Journal Impact Factor: Significance and Implications" was delivered by Dr. Manish Kumar (Assistant Professor In Botany) on 12 October, 2019. This lecture was organized IQAC, SD College Barnala. In his lecture, Dr. Kumar explained the significance of impact factor and how this impact factor is used to compare different journals within a certain field. It is also a powerful tool if you want to compare journals in the subject category. It cannot be used to compare journals across disciplines because citation counts have highly skewed distributions. He also explained the criterion to calculate the impact factor of given journal. He also explained various terms such as H-index, I 10 index etc. He also shed light that Clarivate Analytics releases the Journal Impact Factors annually as part of the Web of Science Journal Citation Reports®. Only journals listed in the Science Citation Index Expanded® (SCIE) and Social Sciences Citation Index® (SSCI) receive an Impact Factor. In the last, faculty members have healthy discussion on above topic and also asked certain queries to the resource person.

## Workshop on U.G.C. Guidelines on Career Advancement Scheme

IQAC of the college organised One Day Workshop on, "U.G.C. Guidelines on Career Advancement Scheme" on 7<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2020. Dr Rajesh Gupta was the resource person. He deliberated in detail regarding the guidelines for promotion of teachers in the college under CAS 2018 as per UGC Regulations 2018. Dr Gupta told that a teacher who wishes to be considered for promotion under CAS will submit in writing to the college that he/she fulfills all the requirements under CAS and also submit Assessment Criteria and Methodology Proforma evolved by Punjab University, supported by all credentials. He discussed in detail the three criteria for promotion such as, a) Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, b) Personal Development Related to Teaching and Research Activities and c) Administrative Support and Participation in Students' Co-curricular and Extra-curricular Activities. He elaborated on the Stages of Promotion under CAS of Incumbent and Newly Appointed Assistant Professors (Stages I, II and III)/Associate Professors/Principals. He explained in detail Table VI-A.a: Assessment Criteria and Methodology for College Teachers (Section B.1 and B.2 of the APAR and PBAS Proformas). Dr Gupta clarified effectively Table VI-A.b: Methodology for College Teachers for Calculating Academic/Research Score (Section B.3 of the APAR and the PBAS Proformas). Participating teachers were provided hand on training in filling in APAR and PBAS Proformas and calculation of various scores. This workshop not only provided information for promotion under CAS but clarified many doubts and misconceptions of the 48 participants especially young faculty members thus proving to be an enriching experience.


























## Report on Workshop Virtual teaching platform

### PLACEMENT CELL

Project Genesis was a Govt Project that was started in 2010 by a joint effort of DPI (Colleges) Punjab and Punjab infotech in collaboration with with Infosys Ltd. Chandigarh, DPI Colleges selected 24 colleges (14 Govt College and 10 Govt aided Colleges ) for this project and S.D College Barnala was also among those selected colleges. Under this project there was organized "Train the trainer" program in which two faculty members from each selected college participated. The purpose of this project was to provide job opportunity to the passing out students of the final year of graduation. Job fairs and pool campus placement drives were held by Infosys BPO Ltd. in the colleges which adopted this project as part of their curriculum and trained the students by giving them regular training in communication skills and analytical skills. Two of our faculty members Prof. Nirmal Gupta Head Department of English and Prof. Shaiffy from Computer Department participated in "Train the traner program" and a class in Communication skills and analytical skills was started in the college campus on 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2010. It was the most valuable trip for me because I gained a lot of knowledge about my scientific research.

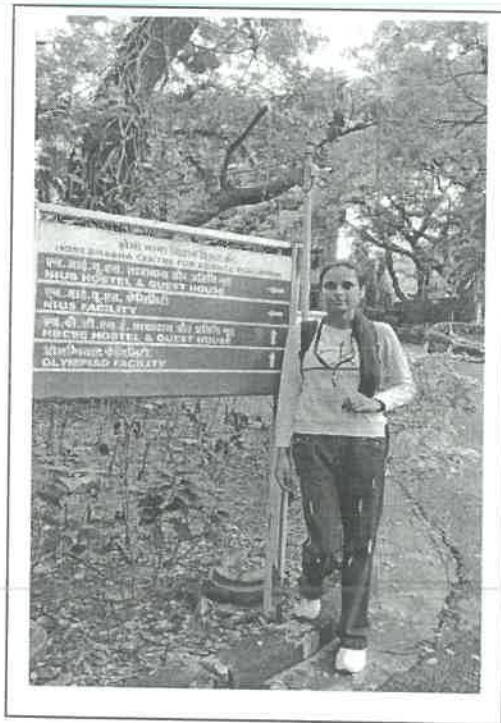

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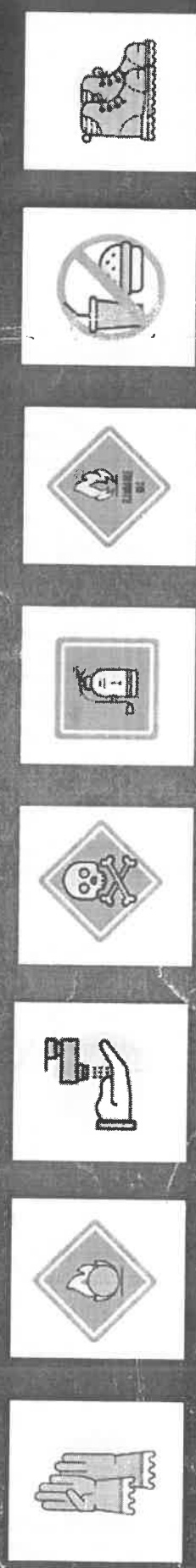

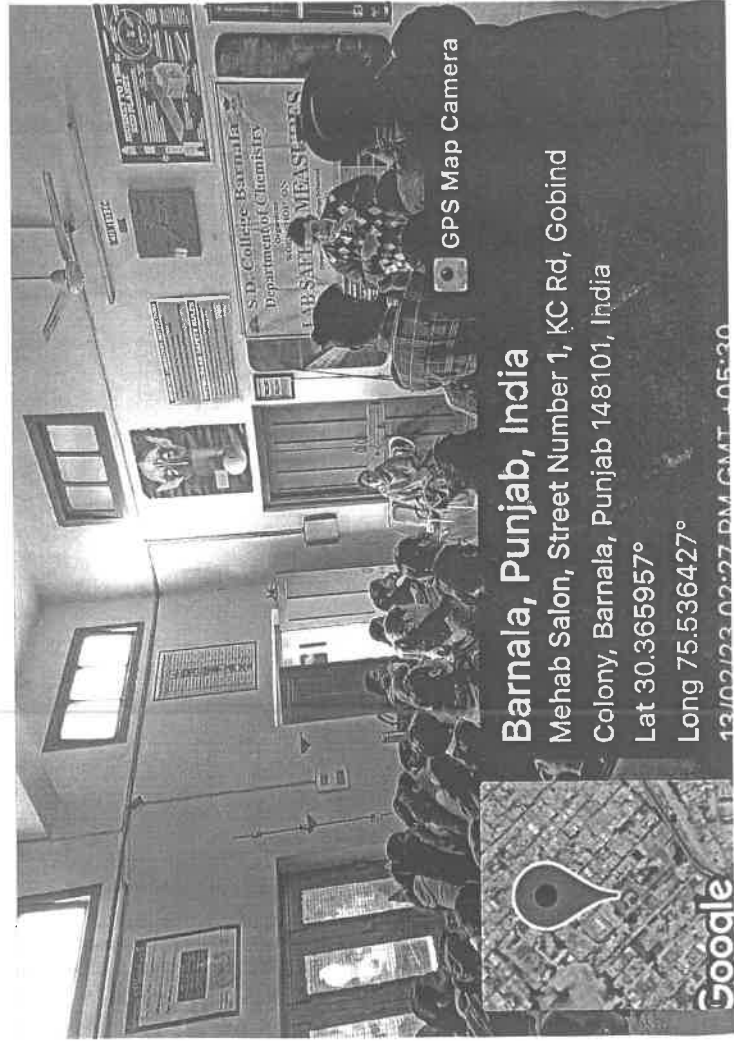
