Subject: Grant of Temporary Affiliation to SD College of Education, Barnala w.e.f. the academic session 2004-2005.


With reference to your letter No. SD-B-2004/2106 dated 3.6.2004, it is hereby informed that subject to the approval of the Academic Council and fulfilment of the following conditions, as laid down by the Inspection Committee, in its report dated 17.7.2004, the Vice-Chancellor has granted temporary affiliation to open new College named **SD College of Education, Barnala** with an intake of 100 students to impart B.Ed. course w.e.f. the academic session 2004-2005:

1. The renovation of the old block of the building may be completed immediately and all the classrooms be furnished with lecture stands. The college will also manage to furnish staff room and girls' common room with appropriate furniture etc. The college will manage to purchase CDs or CD Rome for the Technology Lab.
2. The college will construct independent canteen building within one month.
3. The college would add at least 500 more subject related books to its library within one month. The college will ensure that the library is furnished in all respects.
4. The college will add additional tests to the Psychological Lab.
5. The college would establish a language lab. within one month.
6. The college will manage to prepare independent playgrounds on the adjoining piece of land.
7. The college will appoint Principal, required number of Lecturers and Librarian immediately by 31 July, 2004 as per University/UGC norms. The college will also appoint Instructors in Physical Education and Music, Assistant Librarian and Lab. Attendants.
8. The college will send cases of approval of appointed staff (Principal, Lecturers and Librarian) within one month to the University positively.
9. The college will pay salary to the faculty in the UGC grades and an affidavit to this effect, duly signed by the President of the Foundation/Trust/Institute will be sent to the University.
10. The college will subscribe two English newspapers and three newspapers in vernacular languages. In addition to this, the college will subscribe five journals and two Encyclopaedias relating to the subject of Education.
- ✓ 11. The college will deposit with the University an Endowment Fund amounting to Rs. 10 lacs in the form of FDR which should be in the name of Dean, College Development Council. This FDR should reach this office within fifteen days from the issuance of this letter.

12. In case there is revision in Endowment Fund and Affiliation Fee by the University, the College will be bound to pay the difference.
- ✓ 13. The college will deposit with the University, within fifteen days, temporary affiliation fee amounting to Rs. 50,000/- in the form of Demand Draft, which should be in the name of the Registrar, Punjabi University, Patiala.
14. The college will impart instruction as per University syllabus. The college will charge tuition fees and other funds as laid down by the University. The college will not charge fee/funds over and above the prescribed fee.
15. The college will comply with the rules and regulations issued by the University from time to time.
16. The college building will not be used for any other purpose.
17. The college will make available to the students the playgrounds duly furnished within a time span of one month and an intimation to this effect may be sent to the University.
18. The College must have an arrangement with good practising school. The school should have adequate equipment and experienced staff.
19. The college shall submit at the end of each academic year statement of annual account duly audited by the Chartered Accountant.
20. If the College contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the Punjabi University Calendar, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the University may withdraw affiliation under section 1.1 of Chapter VI, Punjabi University Calendar, Volume I, 1997.
21. The college cannot suspend imparting instruction in the course without prior approval of the University.
22. The College will ensure compliance of conditions of NCTE, Jaipur imposed vide their letter No. F.NRC/NCTE/F-3/PB-117/3978 dated July 7.7.2004.
23. As regards any legal dispute, regarding ownership of land, if any, between the Sabha and the Society, it will be the responsibility of the SD College Educational Society, Barnala, in case the court case is decided otherwise. All liabilities will be borne by the SD College Educational Society, Barnala in respect of the proposed college. The SD College Educational Society would give an affidavit alongwith an undertaking to this effect within 15 days from the despatch of this affiliation letter.

It is hereby clearly stated that the compliance of the above conditions may be ensured within 15 days or as specified, from the date of issuance of the affiliation letter. It is requested that a detailed report of the compliance of the above conditions may be sent to this office and if necessary compliance of the conditions can be checked up again by the University.
